






# Understanding Report Views in i-Ready

\* Students’ scale scores and Placement Levels do not change, just how the report categorizes and color-codes the students.

**Example uses:**

- Standard View across entire school year: Diagnostics 1, 2, & 3.
- Beginning of Year View for Diagnostic 1, Standard View for D2, End of Year View for D3.
- Standard View for Diagnostic 1, End of Year View for D2 and D3.
